Papers must be original and must not have been published or presented at any other meeting prior to the Congress.

DEADLINE for submission: 15 December 2011

- Title of the paper must appear in upper and lower case.
- Abstract should contain no more than 300 words including acknowledgements. Papers exceeding this limit will not be included for print.
- Abstracts should clearly state:
 - Background and objectives
 - Methods
 - Results / Conclusions

Papers stating “data will be discussed in the presentation” will NOT be accepted.

- Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word the first time it appears.
- Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as numerals.

Authors of accepted papers will be informed by December 30, 2011. Authors will then be asked to submit their completed papers.
