



**Correction to the PPS-PIDSP-PFV Childhood Immunization Calendar 2026
July 1, 2026**

An error has been identified in the PPS-PIDSP-PFV Childhood Immunization Calendar 2026, which was launched at the 33rd PIDSP Annual Convention in February 2026 and published on the society's official website.

The error concerns the **Meningococcal B vaccine booster dose schedule** for infants receiving their **first dose at 6-11 months**.

Correction:

	Original Recommendation (Incorrect)	Corrected Recommendation
Age at 1 st dose: 6-11 months	Primary series: 2 doses, at least 2 months apart Booster: 1 dose at 2 years old, at least 2 months after the primary series	Primary series: 2 doses, at least 2 months apart Booster: 1 dose at 12 months onwards , at least 2 months after the primary series

Note: A booster dose received at 2 years old and above is still considered valid, as it satisfies the recommendation to receive the booster at 12 months onwards.
